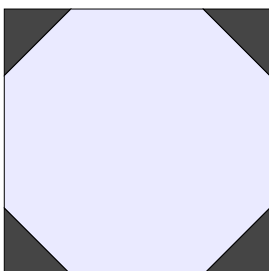


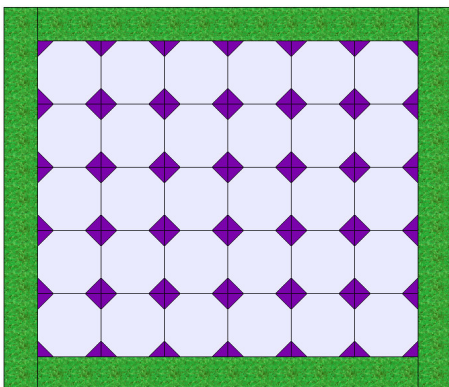
Snowball Quilt- 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block 53x45 $\frac{1}{2}$

Cut 30 large square "A" @ 8 inches
Cut 120 small square "B" @ 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches
Borders- cut 5 strips @ 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Place a small square in a corner of the large square, right sides together. Stitch across the square from corner to corner, press, forming a triangle in the corner. Repeat for the other three corners.



Make 30. Stitch together in rows of five blocks.
Stitch six rows together.
Add borders.



Finished quilt is shown in three colors, but this quilt is very pleasing as a scrap quilt. Keep the corner triangles the same throughout to unify the quilt.
